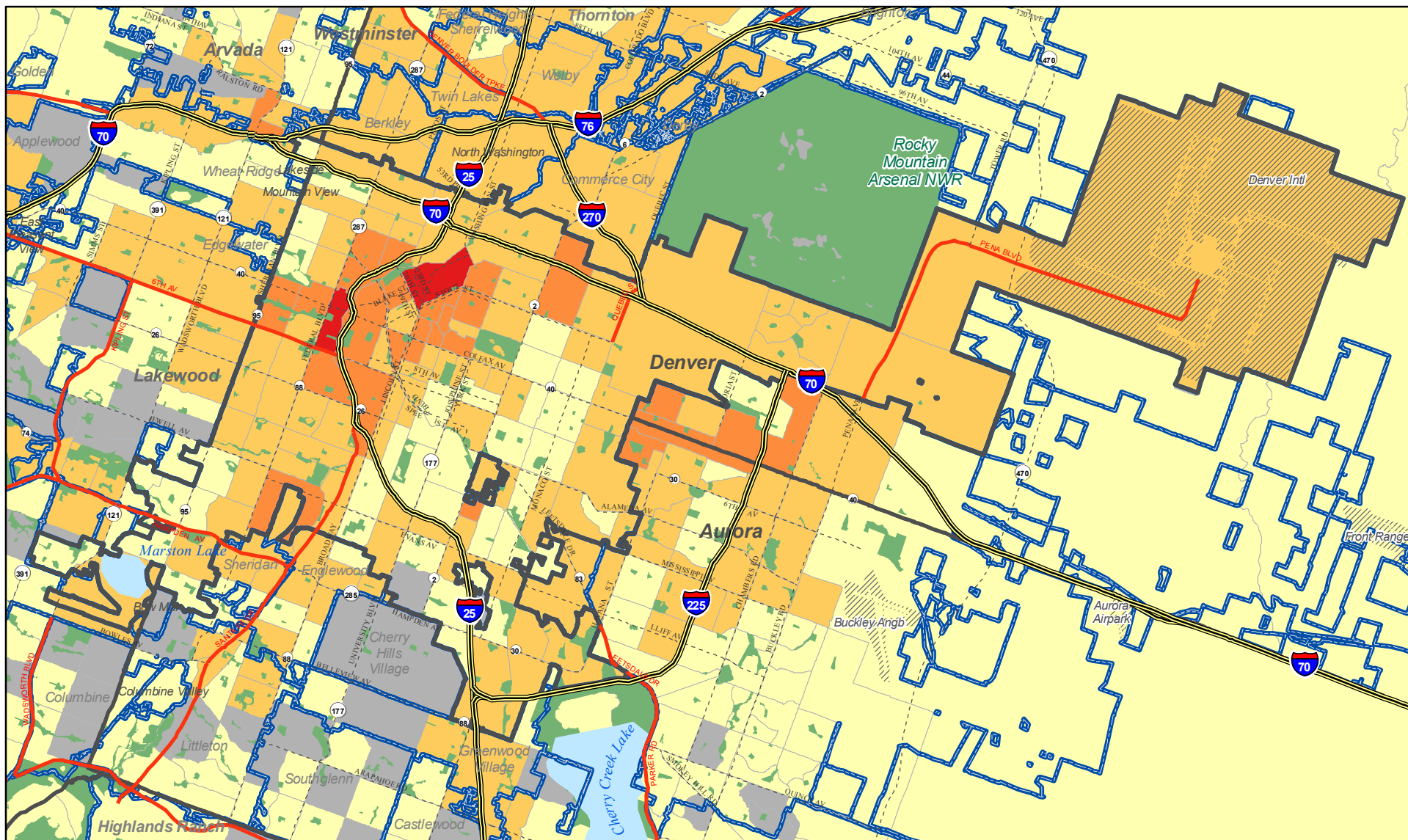











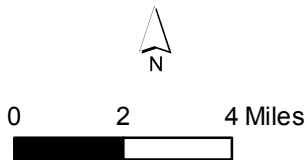


"Hard to count" Census tracts in Denver County, CO based on 2000 Census data

The Census Bureau describes "hard to count" tracts as areas with the greatest challenges to counting the local population for the upcoming 2010 decennial census. Areas with the highest scores (over 70) are likely to be the areas with relatively high undercount rates.
