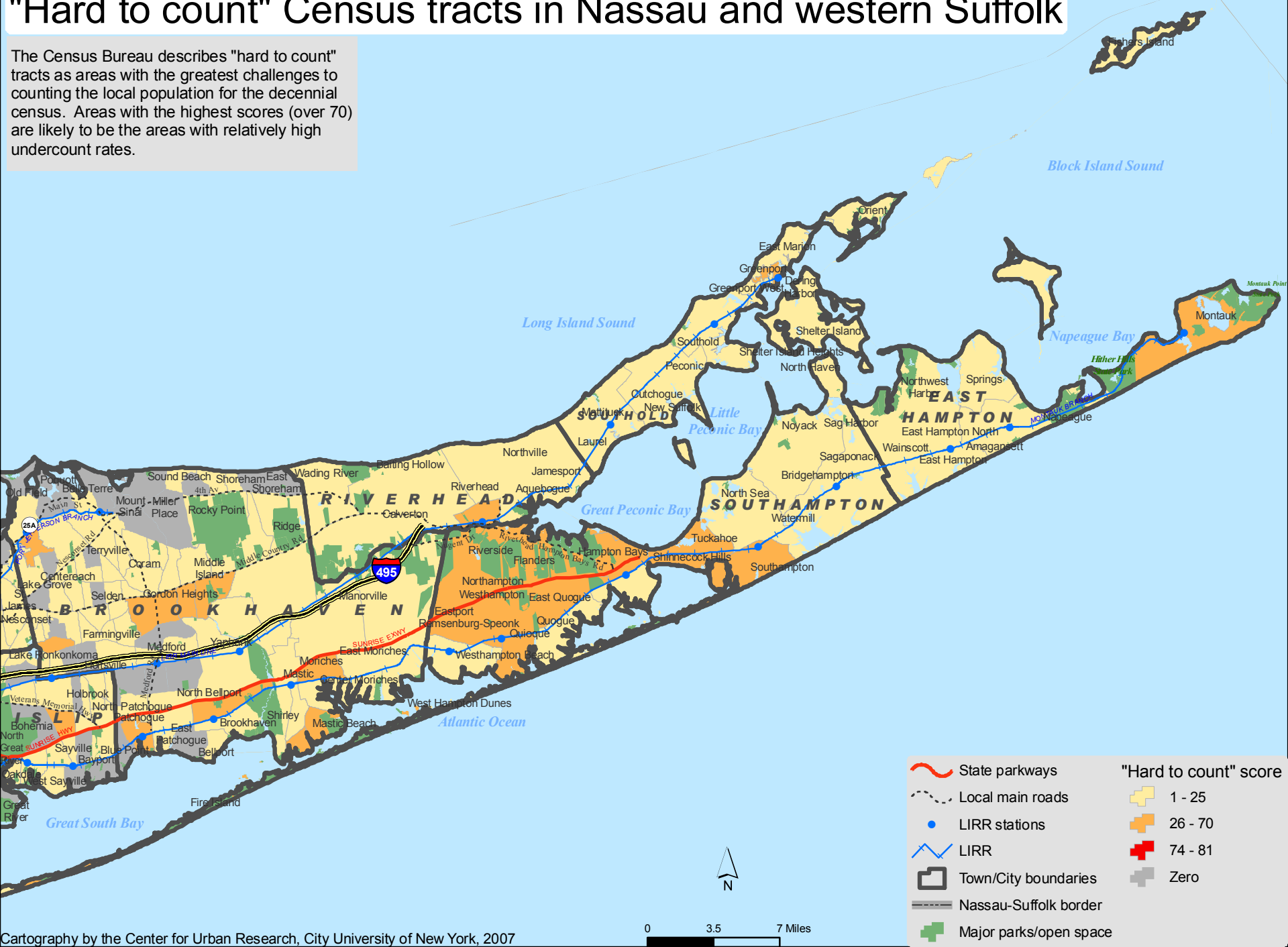


"Hard to count" Census tracts in Nassau and western Suffolk

The Census Bureau describes "hard to count" tracts as areas with the greatest challenges to counting the local population for the decennial census. Areas with the highest scores (over 70) are likely to be the areas with relatively high undercount rates.
